

## **Exhibition of Livestock in Minnesota 2010 Requirements – Motley Fair -**

**GENERAL REQUIREMENTS** - Livestock and poultry that exhibit symptoms of any infectious or communicable disease, including ringworm and warts, may not be exhibited. All animals must be examined by the official veterinarian on the day they are admitted to the exhibition and at least once daily during the exhibition. All imported animals must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection and meet the Board's importation requirements.

**CATTLE** - At this time, there are no state requirements for bovine tuberculosis (TB) testing. However, new intrastate movement requirements may be in effect during the 2010 exhibition season.

**SHEEP & GOATS** - All sheep and goats, including wethers, must be identified with official identification approved for use in the Scrapie eradication program.

**SWINE** - Swine must be individually identified and must: (1) have had a negative official pseudorabies test conducted within 30 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition; or (2) originate directly from a qualified pseudorabies-negative herd; or (3) originate directly from a Stage IV or V county or area. All 50 states are currently pseudorabies Stage V (Pseudorabies Free Status).

**HORSES** - All horses must be negative to an official test for Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) within 12 months prior to the opening date of the exhibition. A test is not required for suckling foals accompanying a negative dam. Horses must be Coggins tested and provide documentation.

**POULTRY** - Poultry, except waterfowl and pigeons, must be individually identified with a leg or wing band and accompanied by a form approved by the board to show compliance with one of the following: negative test for pullorum-typhoid disease conducted within 90 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition; originate directly from parent stock tested and found negative for pullorum-typhoid disease within the last 12 months. In addition, turkeys must be tested negative or originate directly from parent stock that is tested negative for Salmonella typhimurium, Mycoplasma gallisepticum, and Mycoplasma synoviae.

10. Livestock exhibitors must remove all transportation equipment from fairgrounds immediately following unloading. Parking space for trailers, pickups, etc. will be provided outside of the northwest entry gate. Due to the limited space, vehicles used for attending livestock will be allowed fifteen minutes only in grounds.

11. No horses are permitted outside of stalls except for watering, feeding, grooming or judging. Exercising will be done in the grandstand area during posted times only. No horse may be ridden during fair except for day of judging. Horses must be pre-entered by the June 10, due to the early show on entry day.

12. All exhibitors must have health certificates available upon request by the superintendent at time of entry.

13. Exhibitors must furnish their own feed.

### **Division A-Cattle**

Classes as per breed entered. Age by 6-1-10.

Breeds with no competition will be judged together. Not more than two (2) entries per lot, except in group lots where only one entry is allowed.

Premiums 1st-\$10.00, 2nd-\$8.00, 3rd-\$6.00

1. Bull, calf, up to one year of age.
2. Dairy calf, four months to one year.
3. Dairy calf, one year, under two.
4. Dairy, two years, under three.
5. Dairy cow.
6. Produce of Dam; two animals, any age, same dam.
7. Market steer, four months to one year.
8. Market steer, one year, under 18 months.
9. Beef bull calf, four months to one year.
10. Beef heifer under one year.
11. Beef heifer one year, under two years.
12. Beef cow.
13. Beef cow/calf.

#### Division B-Sheep

Breeds with no competition will be judged together. Not more than two (2) entries per lot, except in group lots where only one entry is allowed.

2. January ram lamb, born Jan. 1-31.
3. Junior ram lamb, born after Feb. 1.

5. January ewe lamb, born Jan. 1-31.

7. Flock.

## Division C-Goats

Entry fee: \$2.00

Classes as per breed entered. Age by 6-1-10.

Breeds with no competition will be judged together. Not more than two (2) entries per lot, except in group lots where only one entry is allowed.

Premiums: 1st-\$8.00; 2nd-\$6.00, 3rd-\$4.00.

1. Adult doe, one year and under two.
2. Doe, under one year, over six months.
3. Wether, six months to one year.
4. Produce of Dam; two kids, any sex, from same doe.
5. Buck, under one year, over six months.
6. Buck, over one year
7. Wether kid, up to six months.
8. Doe kid under six months.
9. Adult doe, two years and older.
10. Buck kid, under six months.
11. Llamas, under one year.
12. Llamas, over one year.

## Division D-Poultry

Entry fee: \$1.00

Classes as per breed entered.

Rule A-One entry per lot and pen.

Rule B-Two exhibitors must show in a class to create competition. Breeds having no competition will all be judged together.

Premiums: 1st-\$3.00; 2nd-\$2.00-, 3rd-\$1.50.

Division E-Rabbits

Classes as per breed entered.

No more than one entry per lot. Two exhibitors must show in a class to create competition. Breeds having no competition will be judged together.

Premiums: 1st-\$3.00; 2nd-\$2.00, 3rd-\$1.50.

Lot:

1. Senior Buck, eight months and over.
2. Intermediate Buck, six to eight months.
3. Junior Buck, under six months.
4. Senior Doe, eight months and over.
5. Intermediate Doe, six to eight months.
6. Junior Doe, under six months.
7. Meat Pen, three rabbits three to five pounds, under 69 days.

Division F-Swine

Entry fee: \$2.00

Superintendent: Cody Kosec

Breeds with no competition will be judged together. Not more than two (2) entries per lot, except in group lots where only one entry is allowed.

Classes as per breed entered. Age by 6-1-10.

Premium: 1st-\$8.00; 2nd-\$6.00, 3rd-\$4.00.

Lot:

1. Market Barrow (born on or after March 1).
2. Purebred Gilt (born on or after January 1).
3. Commercial or Crossbred Gilt (born on or after January 1).
4. Feeder Pig (born May 15 - May 31).
